Puzzled? Piecing Together Our Salvation:

Most of us have been Christians for a number of years. In those years, how many times have we heard others express that their salvation was through grace, or faith, or even baptism? Using our Bible, we will examine how we are really saved. We must listen to God and use all the pieces of His instruction in our life in order to be complete and have salvation.

Our Priorities of Life:

Do we really believe that loving God is THE most important commandment? Do we REALLY love Christ with all of our heart? This lesson drives home the point that we are truly known by our fruit. It is vitally important that we ensure that our priorities are set to serve God above all else!

Commissioned To Do Personal Work:

Many Christians today are not interested in doing any personal work. Some may ask “why should I be concerned about personal work?” Others may reason that “it seems to produce such little results.” Jesus commissioned His disciples to do personal work. This lesson will drive home the point that we too have an obligation to carry out the instructions of Jesus and be determined to “seek and save the lost.”

Who Told You?:

When it comes to things religious, that is a very important question. From a very young age we are told various things in the realm of religion – things which we have believed and are practicing. In this lesson we will plainly see that it is the Bible (not our parents, teachers, or peers), that shows us clearly what we are to do in the realm of religion in order to be pleasing to God.

What If?:

We have all been faced with “What if” questions from time to time. In this lesson an examination of God’s Word will focus on some very serious questions that we must consider. God, Christ, and the Holy Spirit has made our salvation possible. Ultimately, we will be held responsible for where we spend our eternity.

Development Through Inventory:

Most Christians are aware of Paul’s admonition “Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith, prove yourself” (2 Corinthians 13:5). Yet this may be one of the most disregarded commandments in God’s Word. We will learn in this lesson why it is so vitally important for each one of us to take inventory of ourselves in order to develop properly in accordance to God’s Word.
